Letters of War

On 3rd November, Family History Society of Cheshire will be holding our AGM at the **Victory Hall in Mobberley**.

WA16 7JQ. At 2pm, in advance of the AGM there will be a performance by Act It Out CIC. All are welcome, entry is from 1pm and **entry is free**.

Originally commissioned as a theatre piece by artist and veteran Mr Frank Foy, 'Letters of War', written by Jill Young, was first performed at the Burslem School of Art during the opening of an exhibition of images of War in 2015. The response was overwhelming and 'Letters' was then performed at the City of Stoke-on-Trent's Somme Commemoration, as well as at various venues across Staffordshire and Cheshire (with bespoke changes in each area it's performed).



Part of the message that audiences receive is that the memories of those that fought in whatever way should never be forgotten. With that in mind Act It Out CIC's directors, Hannah and Jill, created the 'Letters of War' School Workshops that reached over 800 school children throughout Cheshire and Staffordshire with end of project performances reaching audiences of over 2000.

The 35-minute performance, 'Letters of War', tells the story of a small, hard-working family from Stoke. The audience will follow the family through the letters sent to, and from, the Frontline. Our professional actors show the hard-hitting events that might have even happened in your home over 100 years ago.
